Challenge: Create a work of art inspired by an art legend/their creation. In addition to a photo of the artist's creation, a representation of the art serving as inspirational source must also be submitted with this application. By submitting the two images, an efficient comparison can be made for judging inspired art vs. the original art. Make sure to submit the highest quality photos available.

Do not send original artwork. NIRMV will notify art contest participants upon receipt of their entries by email/phone.

Eligibility: Participants must be 18 – 25 years old.

Recognition/Prizes: All participants will receive a certificate. A monetary award of \$100 will be given to the contest winner announced in October 2024. **Decisions of the judges will be final.**

Guidelines and Rules

- Art contest participants are required to submit an essay of 500 words or less with information about the art legend who inspired them. They must submit a representation of the art legend's work plus name and brief description of the legend's art work.
- Participants grant permission for their names, descriptive information, statements, quotes, testimonials and photos (both of themselves and their creation) to be used by NIRMV without notification or compensation. This includes giving NIRMV the final permission to copy or print their submissions in publications for educational, publicity, marketing and promotional purposes plus used on web sites or social media and at public events.
- Participants certify that they have not used copyrighted, trademarked or branded material/logos in their artwork.
- Participants guarantee that their entry is an original work and does not infringe upon the intellectual property right(s) of another such as the unauthorized use of copyrighted, trademarked or branded materials. They indemnify and hold harmless NIRMV from any claims of infringement of intellectual property right by any third party regarding their artwork.
